Cookie "Please Do's"

- Cool, Cool, Cool !!! Otherwise they stick
- Only One Dozen per clear zip lock bag
- Freeze until you can arrange for delivery to or pickup by a team member

Cookie "Please Don't"

Do not add icing or toppings to the cookies
Do not use powdered sugar on the cookies

Write Letters of Hope

Make Placemats

Write letters from God's family to the inmate expressing God's love and encouragement.

- Address to "Dear Brother in Christ"
- Do not seal the envelope
- Short "note" from children has an incredible impact for Christ!
- Children (first name only and age)
- Encouraging scripture verses

Only sign your first name and do not include your return address or phone number.

At each meal, placemats, colored by children, are used. These hand colored placemats are powerful tools of the Holy Spirit that can break open a lifetime of sorrow and let the love of Christ in.



This is a great activity for Sunday school, preschool, children and grandchildren!

Placemat Guidelines

- Decorated by children – include child's first name only and age
- Simple message of God's love
- Preferred size is 8.5in X 14in (Legal size)

Make Posters

Sunday school classes, Bible study groups, reunion groups, youth groups, and even families can make a poster that expresses the hope found in Christ.

Poster Guidelines

- What is on the poster is not so important. It can be a simple trace of hands or a beautiful work of art
- It should have the name of the group
- It should have the group's signatures (first name only and if kids, age)
- No stickers or glue
